
CRITERIA FOR JUNIOR COACHING LEVEL 1 ROACH

- 1. Basic Health and Safety
- 2. Set up a Whip with a pole rig
- 3. Tie a recognised loop knot
- 4. Preparation, care, and use of live maggots
- 5. Use a disgorger to safely remove hooks unaided
- 6. Identify 4 out of 8 fish species
- 7. Basic fish care (All species)





In order to pass Roach Level One, Participants will be required to do the following.

- 1. Attend a tutorial about health and safety at the waters edge.
- 2. After a tutorial that will demonstrate how to set up a Whip and attach a rig, participants will need to show understanding by setting up a Whip on their own.
- 3. After a tutorial that will demonstrate how to tie a recognisable loop knot, participants will then need to show understanding by tying loops on their own
- 4. Participants will be shown how to prepare, take care of, and use live baits like maggots.
- 5. After a tutorial that will demonstrate how to use a disgorger correctly, participants will need to show understanding by using a disgorger on their own
- 6. Participants will be shown eight random pictures of fish of the lead coaches choice. You will need to get four out of the eight correct in order to pass.
- 7. Looking after the fish that you catch is the most important thing to learn. This tutorial will show you how.
