- 2. Make a Pole rig for shallow fishing
- 3. Coach a younger Junior for 3 sessions
- 4. Using a Marker float
- 5. Using Zig rigs
- 6. Make a Ronnie Rig
- 7. Fishing with Chod rigs
- 8. Advanced Watercraft





In order to pass Carp Level seven, Participants will be required to do the following.

- 1. This section is a tutorial that will show you how to make a pole rig for fishing with a bottom bait like expander pellets or maggots.
- 2. You were shown how to 'Slap' in the last level, now you will learn how to make a shallow rig of your own.
- 3. To pass this section you will need to mentor a less experienced Junior for three separate sessions.
- 4. This tutorial will show Juniors how to effectively use a marker float to map out new or unfamiliar venues.
- 5. Juniors will be shown how to make and use Zig rigs for Carp.
- 6. Ronnie rigs are extremely popular and effective. In this section you will be shown how to tie your own.
- 7. Using Chod rigs is essential over ground that has lots of 'rubbish' over the surface. In this section Juniors will learn how and when to make and use them.
- 8. Gathering information about your chosen venue is just one of the many tools available to the modern angler. Advanced water craft is a skill that is a handy one to have when you're chasing those elusive big Carp.
