In order to pass Perch Level Two, Participants will be required to do the following.

- 1. A casting lesson will show you how to cast accurately and safely. (Sandringham Mini Pitch)
- 2. Ready rod holdalls will enable you to take your rods fishing fully assembled and ready to fish. This tutorial will show you how to pack and unpack them correctly.
- 3. Many anglers use a fishing seat box. This tutorial will show you why.
- 4. Getting your ground bait mix just right is vital to successful fishing. This tutorial will teach you how you get it spot on.
- 5. This tutorial will show you to soak micro pellets for use with a Method Feeder and also for general fishing.
- 6. This section will teach you how to assemble a rod and reel for use with a Method Feeder.
- 7. Participants will need to learn the external parts of a fish. Diagrams can be found both in the booklet and in the online booklets.
- 8. Using the correct line for any of your fishing is important. This tutorial will help you choose the right lines for the type of methods, the size of fish, and the time of year.
